



INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR FLEA SERVICE

Preparation is **critical** in flea control and homeowner participation is a **must**. Below you will find the steps that are necessary for you to follow before and after your **FLEA TREATMENT** is performed. Not completing the proper prep for your service will render the guarantee void and may require ACI to reschedule the appointment.

Should our technician arrive, and the steps below have not been taken, rendering the technician unable to do the service, there will be a trip charge of \$55.00 billed to the customer and the service will be rescheduled. Should the treatment be rescheduled, and prep is still not done at that time, 50% of the full-service fee will be charged. If the treatment is rescheduled again and prep is still not completed, the full-service fee will be charged, and treatment will not be rescheduled.

Fleas take a total of 21 days (about 3 weeks) to cycle through their stages of growth. Flea chemicals will ONLY affect the egg, larvae, and adult stages, it will not kill any fleas during the pupae stage. Fleas will have to hatch from this stage and get into the chemical to be controlled. Due to the varying stages of growth, it can take up to 21 days to see complete results. Therefore, NO reservices will be done sooner than 7-14 days (about 2 weeks).

ALL people and pets must be out of the house and off the yard for at least four hours. Birds must be out of the house for 24 hours.

INDOORS

- Sweep, mop and vacuum all floors thoroughly before service. Be sure to remove the vacuum bag and dispose of it in an outdoor trash receptacle. If you have a bagless vacuum cleaner, empty the canister into a plastic bag and take it to an outdoor trash receptacle.
- Put all pet dishes and toys away. Wash pet bed(s) in hot water and dry on the hottest setting allowed.
- All children's toys, small items that sit on the floor, etc. Need to be removed from the area.
- AFTER** treatment, sweep and vacuum all floors thoroughly, do NOT mop. Be sure to remove the vacuum bag and dispose of it in an outdoor trash receptacle. If you have a bagless vacuum cleaner, empty the canister into a plastic bag and take it to an outdoor trash receptacle.

OUTDOORS

- If you have a crawl space under the home, all openings should be sealed off to avoid animals from gaining access. If this is not done, the warranty will be void.
- All grass and weeds must be mowed down to 6" or less.
- All pet dishes, children's toys and pet feces must be picked up.
- All pets must be treated with flea prevention within 24hrs.
